- People from **diverse backgrounds** and experiences, including from the communities most often served by WAAM.

Board members are required to sign a Board Commitment Letter which provides details on individual requirements and responsibilities, attend 75% of all Board meetings throughout the year (held every other month) and utilize their network to support WAAM's mission and endeavors.
